Conservation of biological diversity and ecological integrity.

Conserve the variety of all life forms and species and ensure that the productivity, stability and resilience of ecosystems is maintained.

Inter-generational equity.

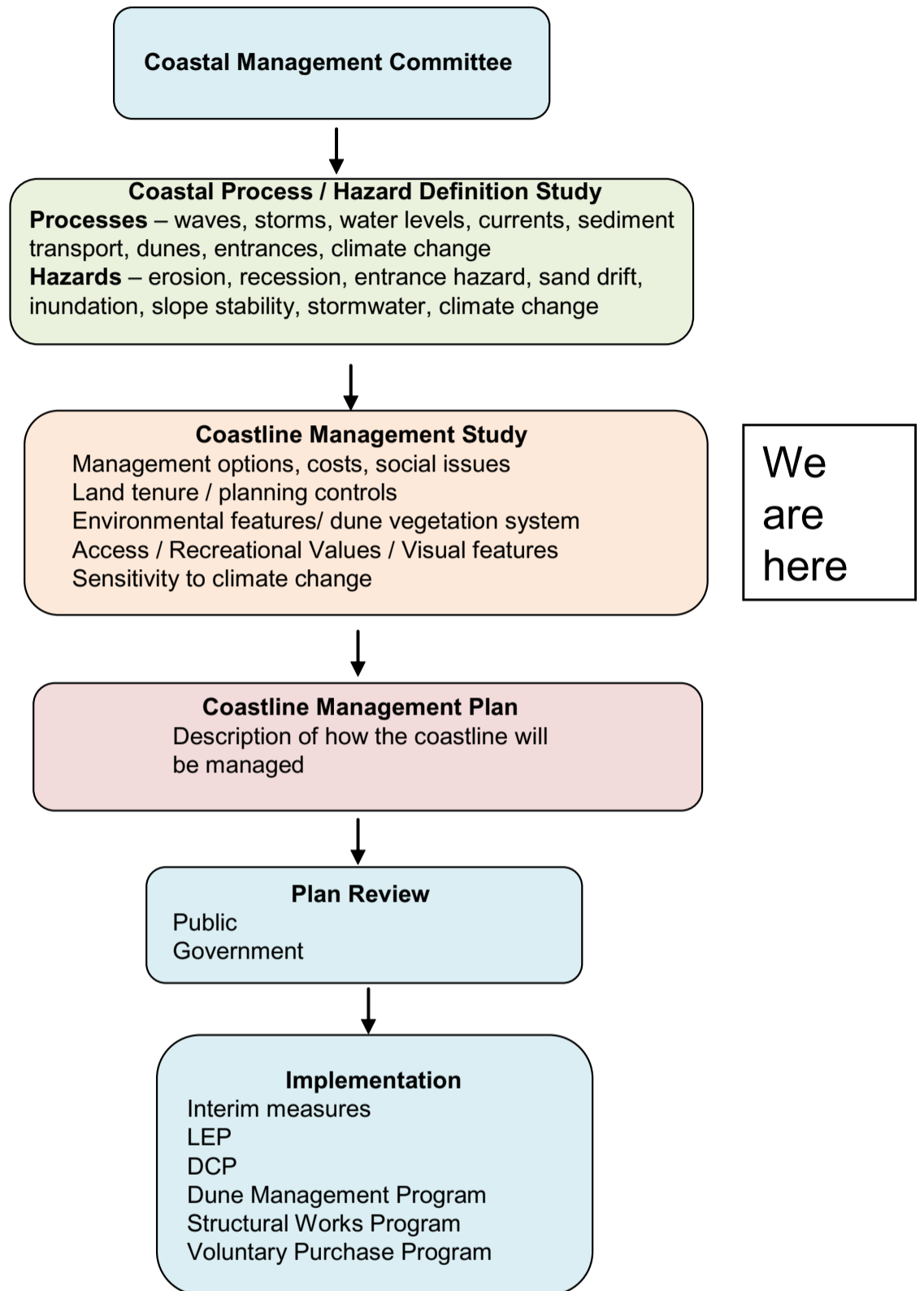
Health, diversity and productivity of the environment is maintained or enhanced for the benefit of future generations. Social equity considerations in terms of equal access opportunities to resources.

Improved valuation, pricing and incentive mechanisms.

Environmental factors, such as the value of ecosystems, to be incorporated into the valuation of assets and services and considered in decision-making

The precautionary principle.

Where there are threats of serious or irreversible environmental damage, lack of full scientific certainty is not to be used as a reason for postponing measures to prevent environmental degradation.
